

Dear Owner / Occupier,

Sefton Park Vitality Trail

Liverpool City Council have appointed Dowhigh Limited to carry out the Sefton Park Vitality Trail programme of works. This has been scheduled to take place on Monday 23rd October 2017, with a duration of approximately 12 weeks.

The site will stretch to around 1.5 km and will encompass, new footpaths, kerbs, street furniture, lighting and drainage to make ready for timber trim trail equipment to be positioned at intervals along the prepared location. The work schedule will be achieved through a 5 phased approach as follows:-

- * **Phase 1 – 23rd October to 3 November 2017 (Croxteth Gate to the Obelisk)**
- * **Phase 2 – 6 November to 17 November 2017 (Obelisk to the Junction of Lark Lane)**
- Phase 3 – 20 November to 1 December 2017 (Lark Lane to Junction of Livingston Drive North)**
- Phase 4 – 4 December to 15 December 2017 (Livingston Drive North to Livingston Drive South)**
- Phase 5 – 3 January 2018 to 19 January 2018 (Livingston Drive South to Mossley Hill Drive)**

Drainage works will be completed during phase 3 and phase 5 from the 20 November 2017 until 20 December 2017.

The Exercise Equipment and tiger mulch along with the finally fix electrics will occur during the period 8 January 2018 until 26 January 2018.

The majority of the work will be undertaken with lane closures and footpath restrictions. Road signage will be in place to notify motorists of any changes to the traffic configuration in advance of the work beginning.

We are working closely with a professional arborist to ensure the maintenance of the trees, landscape and habitat are fully protected during each phase of the works.

As with all major road works of this nature, it is inevitable that some disruption will be caused. However, this will be kept to an absolute minimum.
