Dear Parent/Carer

We are now well into the examination season and I am very aware of how hard your daughter's year group has been working in recent weeks and how well the girls have conducted themselves during the actual examinations.

To recognise the maturity with which the girls have applied themselves, I have decided to grant Year 11 study leave following the end of lessons on Friday 25th May. Please note details of the additional support on offer attached to this letter and we strongly advise students to avail of this support.

Examinations still remain to be completed in the following subjects:

- * History and Geography
- * English and Maths
- * Science
- * Option subjects

Please do not underestimate the part that you have to play in ensuring that your daughter arrives to any scheduled lessons and exams on time and in helping her to achieve the right balance between revision and other pursuits in the coming weeks. We strongly advise that she sticks to a daily timetable of revision at home where distractions can be kept to a minimum. Your daughter is required to be on the playground for morning exams no later than 8.45a.m. and 12.45p.m. for afternoon examinations. **Should she fail to attend any exam, parents/carers will be required to pay the examination fee.** Your daughter has been provided with the dates and times of her examinations and we ask parents/carers to check that no pupil misses an examination.

It is very important that your daughter returns all books and equipment to school on the days she has a final examination in each particular subject. Failure to do so will result in her Progress File being withheld until all books and equipment have been returned or paid for. Pupils are required to come in for any scheduled lessons and their exams wearing full school uniform. Please note that the same school rules on uniform, jewellery, hairstyles and make-up apply throughout the examination period and only end after the official leaving date.

There will be a final celebration for Year 11 pupils after the examinations, at which Progress files will be distributed. (You will be sent a separate letter in due course with further information about this event). **GCSE results will be available on Thursday 23rd August from 9am in the Marie Madeleine Hall.**
