Year 4/5 Taster Day and Uniform

Each year the school provides a day of lessons for Year 4 and 5 girls from many Catholic primary schools across the city. This is to give these girls a 'taste' of what it is like at secondary school and in Bellerive FCJ in particular. **For this reason the school will be closed on Monday, 25th June for most pupils, and most 6th Form students.** (Any 6th Formers who have exams that day or who are involved in collaborative lessons in one of our partnership 6th Forms would be expected to attend as required).

Those pupils who will be helping in classrooms on the day will be in school for part of the day. (If your child is required in school for this reason you will receive a separate letter with details and a reply slip in due course from any of the Heads of Department needing assistance).

If you are unable to arrange care for your child on this day please write a note to this effect and ask your child to pass it by hand to Mr. Higgins, by Wednesday, 20th June. If necessary, your daughter can be supervised in school on that day but only if we have received your request by 20th June.

All pupils and 6th Form students must be back in school on Tuesday, 26th June.

If you know of somebody who currently has a daughter in Y4 or Y5 at primary school please tell the family about our Taster Day and ask them to ring school for further details.

Pupils will be allowed, **for the rest of the summer term only**, to come into school without their jumpers. This will be at your discretion. Blazers must be worn. As always, if your daughter needs to wear her outdoor coat on any school day she must also wear her blazer. During lessons, blazers may be removed, at the discretion of the teacher. We would ask that if wearing a shirt without a jumper, that girls wear suitably coloured underwear.

Thank you for your continuing support in ensuring that our pupils look smart and presentable both in school and out, when wearing their uniform.
