Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Parking outside of school

You will be aware that both sides of the road outside the Sefton Park building are designated as cycle lanes. They have been marked out in red and it is illegal to drive into these lanes or to stop in them.

Local councillors and members of the cycling community have come into school to speak with me. We have also had contact from traffic management and environmental health personnel from Liverpool Council. They are concerned about the number of vehicles that are parked on both sides of the road, predominantly at the start, the end of the school day and on a Tuesday afternoon when Resonate are in school.

The white lines in the centre of the road opposite the entrance to the Sefton Park building comprise a ghost island and are not parking spaces!

I am writing to ask that you park in the designated bays around the perimeter of Sefton Park and walk to the school entrance whenever you are coming to school, for whatever reason.

There have also been an increasing number of cars parking on the zig zags near the crossing on Ullet Road when dropping pupils off. May I remind you that this is also a traffic offence, as well as a hazard to others.

Traffic enforcement officers and the police will be deployed in the area and you risk a fine if you are found to be breaking traffic laws.

I hope you can support us to make the school environs a safer place.
