Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to reassure you about your daughter's application to Bellerive Sixth Form. These are extremely worrying times for all, and I wanted to clarify some of the plans that we have in place for the next academic year.

You have received a letter from Ofqual about how GCSE grades are being awarded this year and we believe that results will be published on 20th August 2020 as was originally planned, and therefore we will be offering places from this date onwards.

Due to the unusual circumstances that we find ourselves in, we have decided to expand our number of places in our 6th Form for Bellerive students. The entry requirements for Bellerive Sixth form are in the Sixth Form prospectus which you have received and is also available on the school website. We are doing this to ensure that our Year 11 students are not disadvantaged in the future.

We hope to hold a guidance interview with your daughter over the telephone, and you will be receiving a call from a member of the Senior Leadership Team within the next few weeks, to discuss your daughter's subject choices based on her grades and teacher knowledge of her aptitude and work ethic.

In the next few weeks, subject teachers will be making preparative Year 12 work available in their subjects so that students can be ready and better equipped for their studies in our sixth form. They will be invited to choose a few subjects that they are interested in following before making any final decisions. I will be providing details of this in the near future.

I hope that you and your family are keeping safe, and we look forward to seeing your daughter in our 6th Form.
