Consultation on change of admissions arrangements

1. Introduction

- 1.1. Bellerive FCJ Catholic College ("the school") is a single academy trust within the trusteeship of the Sisters, Faithful Companions of Jesus and acts as its own admissions authority.
- 1.2. The School has an age range of 11 to 18 and a published admissions number ("PAN") of 180.
- 1.3. The Governors have considered the admissions arrangements for the School and have reviewed the PAN. It has been determined that the PAN will reduce to 150 for 2026-2027 onwards. An additional criterion has been included as Criterion 7. The changes are highlighted in the Admissions Policy attached.
- 1.4. No other changes to the admissions arrangements are proposed at this stage.
- 1.5. For the avoidance of doubt, this consultation applies to the admissions arrangements from September 2026.

2. Consultation responses

- 2.1. This consultation document has been circulated to all stakeholders as required.
- 2.2. The consultation period will be held between 18/12/2024 and 28/01/2024.
- 2.3. All stakeholders wishing to submit a response to this consultation should complete the consultation form under annexe 1 of this consultation document.
