2	Dance Appreciation – Written Paper Set Phrases Duo / trio Choreography	Section C- Dance Anthology. Pupils continue to study the dance anthology as they prepare for the written examination in June. In practical lessons, students complete the set phrases assessment – Scoop and Flux. Pupils will record their final duo performance in this term. Students will focus this term on their choreography in practical lessons. They will carry forward their research from term 1 to inform their choices as they choreograph and submit their choreography performance.	Pupils will complete the course by February and then revise for the written paper. Students will work on the set phrases and duo/trio performances, filming and submitting them in the first half of the term. Choreography will be recorded and submitted in the second half of term 2.
