Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your support and understanding today regarding the school closure. We do understand the difficulties this may cause and it's not a decision we took lightly. We hope to open tomorrow, but will again plan a delayed start, to give us more time to assess the conditions on site and ensure we have enough staff available to safely look after our students.

- Students should make their way in for a 10.00am start.
- They will go straight to lesson 2 at 10.05am.
- School buses will start approximately 90 minutes later than they normally would. We cannot give exact times for each stop as its impacted by traffic so we would advise your daughter to be at the bus stop early. Planned times for the buses starting their pickups are as follows:

BR1	-	09.00	first stop
BR2	-	08.55	first stop
BR3	-	09.05	first stop
BR4	-	09.00	first stop
BR5	-	08.55	first stop

- If a decision is taken to close the school on safety reasons, this will made by 8.30am.
- This will be communicated via our website and social media in the first instance.
