


A-Level SPANISH



What will I study?

Students taking Spanish are taught by subject specialists. The focus of the course is learning about the Spanish-speaking world, which is enhanced by a deepening of the understanding of how the language works. Some of the key areas studied: social aspects such as changes in modern family values, gender equality, immigration, cyberspace, artistic and cultural heritage in the Hispanic world as well as political issues.

How will I be assessed?

- AQA exam board
- Paper 1: Listening, Reading & Writing ('writing' is referring to summarising) 50% of overall grade.
- Paper 2: Writing (two essays: one based on a film and one based on a literature work) 20% of overall grade.
- Paper 3: Speaking (two parts: a speaking card based on topics covered during Year 12 and 13 and an presentation and a discussion based on a topic of your choice) 30% of overall grade.
