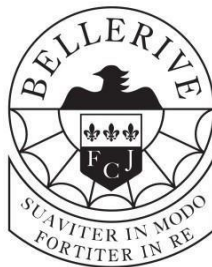
Consultation on change of admissions arrangements for 2027/28

1. Introduction

- 1.1. Bellerive FCJ Catholic College ("the school") is a single academy trust within the trusteeship of the Sisters, Faithful Companions of Jesus and acts as its own admissions authority.
- 1.2. The School has an age range of 11 to 18 and a published admissions number ("PAN") of 150.
- 1.3. The Governors have considered the admissions arrangements for the school and have proposed the following changes:
 - The subcategories 1a, 1b and 5a, 5b have been removed and all the information has been combined into criteria 1 and 5 respectively.
 - To add an oversubscription priority for girls who will have a sister in the school at the date of admission.
 - To update the pastoral areas in line with the Archdiocese Families of Parishes
- 1.4. Further information has been provided under the following sections:
 - Procedures for making an application
 - Late applications
 - Fair access protocols
 - Admissions into Year 12 and 13
 - Criteria for In-Year admissions
- 1.5. No other changes to the admissions arrangements are proposed at this stage.
- 1.6. For the avoidance of doubt, this consultation applies to the admissions arrangements from September 2027.

2. Consultation responses

- 2.1. This consultation document has been circulated to all stakeholders as required.
- 2.2. The consultation period will be held between 10/12/2025 and 21/01/2025.
- 2.3. All stakeholders wishing to submit a response to this consultation should complete the consultation form under annex 1 of this consultation document.
