Your daughter is now approaching an important stage in her education. Over the coming weeks, she will begin making decisions about the subjects she wishes to study at GCSE, choices that will shape her learning journey throughout Key Stage 4 and help lay the foundation for her future aspirations.

This morning, students took part in an introductory assembly outlining the options process and we are very much looking forward to welcoming both parents and students to our Parents and Pathways Evening, which will take place tomorrow. This event provides an excellent opportunity to meet with subject teachers, learn more about the Key Stage 4 courses on offer, ask questions, and seek guidance from our school Careers Advisor.

To support students in making well-informed and confident decisions, I am also sharing a copy of the Year 9 Options Booklet.
